DIRECTION RECEIVED

Receives general supervision which consists of oral assignments and/or rough sketches of work projects-completed work is spot checked for accuracy and acceptability.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED

As required, may supervise work of several lower graded draftsman.

MAJOR DUTIES

From oral assignments and/or rough sketches plans complex drawings indicating as required, such details and pertinent information as fire protection system, safety limits accessibility, requirements in the operations of an ammunition maintenance building operational speed, explosion proofing, space utilization, lighting, distance of movement, appearance and overall efficiency of the operation. Prepares and devises complex technical drawing of equipment, machinery and tools used for renovation, modification, demilitarization and destruction of ammunition. Submits plans for review and approval prepares final drawings, assists superior in studies and computation.
